
THE CHANGING FACE OF THE BARREL

The dramatic rise in US shale output has transformed the quality of oil on the global oil market adding a glut of light sweet crude. OPEC, Russia, and its allies — the bulk of which produce heavy sour crude — have tried to balance the market by making significant output cuts. This has created a huge imbalance between sweet and sour crude and light and heavy oil, profoundly impacting every part of the barrel and the oil sector. This shift in crude quality poses a fresh set of challenges for refiners, producers and consumers.
